

Grant Lewandowski (6-0, 180) has been our leading receiver for the past 2 seasons. He has and big play threat. He blocks well on the edge and takes pride in being physical, which is vital in our typically run first offense. He is also extremely intelligent with the game in recognizing coverages and running quality routes. Defensively he is stepping into a bigger role in using his skills in coverage.

Chris Janssen (6-5, 200) was our amazing surprise last year defensively. He set single sea-




