The Crete Board of Education approved the following budget on Monday September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024, during the regular board meeting. This is a different budget than what was printed in the Crete News on September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

Here is a summary of the changes from the original budget to the adopted budget:

The Special Building Fund budget was changed from \$4,606,453.00 to \$3,611,803.00

The Qualified Capital Purpose Undertaking Fund budget was changed from \$225,002.00 to \$2.00.

The necessary cash reserve in the General Fund changed from \$1,332,591.00 to \$1,277,760.00.

Property Tax Request changed from a total of \$17,666,516.00 to \$15,773,101.00. This is because the Crete Board of Education decided to limit the impact on taxpayers this year since valuations increased by 5%.
