Taylor Michelle Clayton is the daughter of Kevin and Rebecca Clayton.

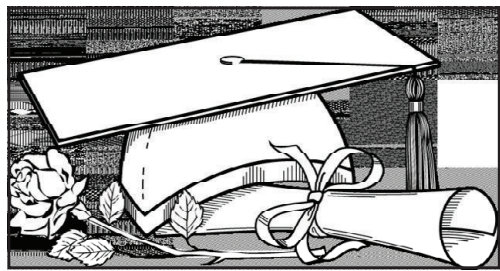
While in high school, Taylor was active in Drama (9-12), ISE (9-12), Black Experience (9-11), SADD (9-11), and Spanish club (9-12).
