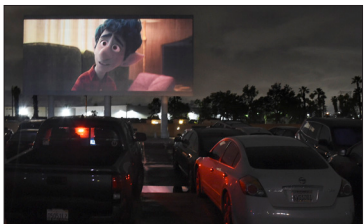

Young reporter reopens old murder case in 'Home Before Dark'

If print journalism has a future, it might lie with young Hilde Lisko.

As played by Brooklynn Prince ("Monsters at Large") in the Apple TV+ mystery series "Home Before Dark," which begins streaming Friday, April 3, she's a nine-year-old investigative reporter and editor of her own newspaper who thinks critically, strives to see things as they really are and questions everything.

It's obvious where she gets those instincts from. Her dad, Matthew (Jim Sturgess, "Hard Sun"), was a reporter for a major New York newspaper until he lost his job and thus was forced to relocate west with Hilde, wife Bridget (Abby Miller, "Justified") and other daughters Izzy and Ginny (Kylie Rogers, Mila Morgan) to his lakeside hometown. It is there where Hilde's nose for the news kicks in as she latches onto an unsolved murder case from years earlier that many in the sleepy burg, Matthew included, would just as soon keep buried.

The story is inspired by the real-life reporting of young investigative journalist Hilde Lysiak and her

relationship with her father, Matthew, a former crime reporter for the New York Daily News. That father-daughter dynamic is at the heart of this series and so when the part of Matthew was cast, Prince – who had already been tabbed to play Hilde – was asked which actor she preferred.

"I could just tell that he was fun," the young actress says of the British Sturgess, "and that he was going to actually be the one. And at the end of the day, they're like, 'Which one did you like most?' I'm like, 'I like Jim Sturgess.'"

"I think it was so important for them and for everybody involved that that kind of dynamic was going to work," adds Sturgess, a bachelor with no children of his own, "because it was so at the forefront of the show. But yeah, it was crazy. We spent a few hours, I think, just kind of hanging out, telling each other stories. We did some improvisation stuff and we read a couple of the scenes ... and people are filming you doing it while you're hanging out. It was kind of weird."

The two actors also had access to the real-life players. While Sturgess had limited time with Matthew

Lysiak, he immediately saw his real-life counterpart's journalistic instincts come to the fore. "He ends up asking you more questions about you than I got to ask about him," Sturgess says. "He was way more fascinated and wanted to know about my life. I was like, 'No, no, no. I'm supposed to be learning about your life.'"

Meanwhile, Prince bore witness to the precocious Hilde's enormous vocabulary. "She says stuff like 'supercalifragilisticexpialidocious' and I'm like, 'Wait, what?' That is so super-fancy and for a nine-year-old, you'd expect them to be playing with Barbies and just discovering the world and playing in the world. And you look at Hilde and she's a journalist and she is doing all these amazing things and you're like, 'Wow! She's only nine years old.'"

Together, they're a force of two, which is also what both actors wanted to replicate.

"If you ever see Hilde and Matt together," Sturgess says, "it's really quite special. It's really special to see them sort of interact with each other and they seem so connected as a force."

Elisabeth Moss' Top 10 Movies

"The Kitchen" (2019): Moss shares the star power with Melissa McCarthy and Tiffany Haddish in this tale of wives of jailed mobsters who carry on their husbands' business.

"Us" (2019): In writer-director Jordan Peele's eerie chiller, Moss plays a woman who gives credence to the notion that everyone has a mirror image.

"The Old Man & the Gun" (2018): Moss is part of a stellar cast in this tale of a prison escapee (Robert Redford) who becomes something of a folk hero as he resumes his life of crime.

"The Seagull" (2018): This adaptation of the Anton Chekhov classic gives Moss the role of Masha and places her in another hugely impressive cast.

"Truth" (2015): Moss is in Redford's company again in this dramatization of a "60 Minutes" scandal as a colleague of Dan Rather (Redford), who fronted a story that later was retracted by CBS News.

"The One I Love" (2014): Moss and Mark Duplass are compelling as a couple whose vacation turns out to be anything but relaxing.

"On the Road" (2012): Not the easiest story to film, Jack Kerouac's literary classic about one of the ultimate road trips counts Moss among its stars.

"Get Him to the Greek" (2010): Humor is Moss' main mission as the girlfriend of Jonah Hill's character as the latter has to keep an eye on a troublemaking rock star (Russell Brand) before a Los Angeles concert.

"Girl, Interrupted" (1999): Under James Mangold's ("Ford v Ferrari") direction, Moss makes an impact opposite Winona Ryder and Oscar winner Angelina Jolie as a fellow patient in a mental hospital.

"Anywhere but Here" (1999): Susan Sarandon and Natalie Portman understandably get the lion's share of the attention in this mother-daughter drama, but Moss still makes her presence known in support of them.

Elisabeth Moss faces off against an 'Invisible Man'

It can be a dicey proposition to update a horror classic. You can look out of step if you're too nostalgic, or disrespectful if you take too many liberties.

That's what makes "The Invisible Man" (available On Demand) such a modest triumph. While fully acknowledging the original H.G. Wells story and earlier screen versions, it modernizes the tale in an extremely effective way ... thanks in no small part to a superb performance by Elisabeth Moss, of "The Handmaid's Tale" and "Mad Men" fame, as a victim of an abusive relationship.

She deals with a mad man of a different kind here, since her character continues to be victimized after her abuser apparently is gone. He's a scientific genius she leaves at the start of the film, and played

by Oliver Jackson-Cohen, he has the technical know-how to keep an eye on her even when she can't see him vengefully doing it – but she knows he's there.

It's not fair to spoil the twists of "The Invisible Man," but as he's done with the "Saw" and "Insidious" series, writer-director Leigh Whannell has taken conventions of the genre and given them really fresh spins. And in this MeToo era, the approach of the update is especially relevant and unnerving.

Moss makes a great representative for that, with her award-winning "Handmaid's Tale" work serving as an ideal undercurrent for what she does here. Her latest alter ego is very much a modern woman going up against classic terror, but with a contemporary overlay

that is obvious and ingenious at the same time. The invisible fellow always had an advantage over his targets – with him able to see them while they couldn't reciprocate – but that has extra, even eerier meaning now.

It also helps "The Invisible Man" succeed where some of its other horror-classic updates of recent years didn't, a sadly notable example being Tom Cruise's stab at "The Mummy." With audiences being that much more sophisticated now, it takes something additional and smart to make such an effort work, and "The Invisible Man" positions itself as a textbook example for such attempts going forward. A god supporting cast that also includes Aldis Hodge, Storm Reid ("A Wrinkle in Time") and Harriet Dyer (TV's "The InBetween") also helps.

Just when you might think, "Not another horror remake," comes "The Invisible Man." And even if its title villain isn't always visible, he sure makes his presence felt.

The drive-in, relic of yesterday, finds itself suited to now

The drive-in theater, long a dwindling nostalgia act in a multiplex world, is experiencing a momentary return to prominence.

With nearly all of the nation's movie theaters shuttered due to the coronavirus pandemic, some drive-in owners think they're in a unique position to give moviegoers a chance to do something out of the house while keeping distance from others. This weekend, some drive-ins aren't the only show in town. They're the only show in the country.

The Showboat Drive-In Theater in Hockley, Texas, about a 30-minute drive outside Houston, normally sees ticket sales go down about 40% on a weekend when they don't have new movies. Last weekend, they saw a 40% increase, says the theater's owner, Andrew Thomas. Usually open weekends, Thomas has kept screenings going through the week.

"Obviously this isn't the way you'd want it to occur, but I'm excited for the idea that there may be a new generation of people that will get to

experience going to a drive-in theater and — I was going to say catch the bug," said Thomas, laughing. "Maybe some other turn of phrase."

There are just over 300 drive-ins left in the country. They constitute a small, oft-forgotten flicker in today's movie ecosystem that hardly competes with the megawatt glare of the megaplex and the nation's 5,500 indoor theaters. But through decades of disruption and change in American life, they have managed to survive. They've somehow clung to life as relics of past Americana only to find themselves, for a brief moment anyway, uniquely suited to today

Not many drive-ins are open. It's a seasonal business to begin with, with many drive-ins not planning to open until April. John Vincent, president of the United Drive-In Theater Owner Association, estimates about 5-10% were open as of last weekend, and some of those are closing due to the pandemic. In states like California and New York, restrictions on movement and gathering are being ramped up that mandate closures. As infections rise in other parts of

the country, Vincent suspects the drive-in's window is already closing.

However long it lasts, the drive-in is for now, in certain parts of the country, one of the only remaining refuges of public entertainment — of getting out the house to do something while still staying inside your car. At the Paramount Drive-in near Los Angeles, Forrest and Erin McBride figured a drive-in movie was one of the only ways they could responsibly celebrate their anniversary.

"We were like, what can we do? Everything's closed," said Forrest before a showing of "Onward" on Thursday night. "We were like, 'Well, a drive-in theater is kind of like a self-quarantined movie date.'"

Drive-ins aren't without their own virus concerns. Concessions and restrooms, in particular, still pose issues. All owners interviewed for this article said they were spacing out cars, reworking how customers could order food (sometimes via text messages) and limiting restroom occupancy.

Chris Curtis, owner of the Blue Moon Drive-in in Guin,

Alabama, said he was doing something that has long been anathema to drive-ins: allowing outside food and drink in. "In fact, we suggest it," reads the Blue Moon's Facebook page. Like indoor theaters, drive-ins make their money almost entirely by concessions.

"We're just trying to pay the power bill and the water bill and get through this, and give the community something to do at a time when there's not a whole lot to do," said Curtis, who's owned the Blue Moon for 24 years. "It's not about the movies anymore. It's about having something to do."

Curtis is concerned that too many people could show up this weekend, given the responses he's gotten. To keep the Blue Moon uncrowded, Curtis launched online ticketing for the first time. "I don't want people driving from long distances just to see that we're sold out," he said.

There are few movies left for drive-ins to play. For now, they can still screen recent releases like "Onward" and "The Hunt," but those movies are already available on various digital platforms as studios have funneled their films to homes due to the virus. Earlier this week, all of the nation's movie chains shuttered following federal guidelines that urged against gatherings of more than 10 people. The studios have cleared out their release calendars into May.

Those postponements have extended all the way to major summer releases, including Marvel's "Black Widow" (previously slated for May 1). Eating into spring releases will be hard enough for drive-ins, but summer is when they sell most of their tickets. Owners say that if they manage to remain open in the coming weeks, they could potentially play older films (though those cost almost as much as new releases to play).

"We don't know how long we're going to have to live this way," said Thomas. "Everybody's wrestling with what it is going to be like in the middle of the summer when normally everyone is high-fiving and having a good time because the box office is going crazy. It's when you go: This is why I got into this business."

Drive-ins could also improvise in other ways. Lisa Boaz, who with her husband has operated the Monetta Drive-in in Monetta, South Carolina, since 1999, said they've been contacted by churches interested in using the drive-in for Sunday services. Parishioners would listen to sermons from their cars through the drive-in's FM-radio transmitters.

"We're kind of playing it by ear right now," said Boaz.

Boaz said they had opened the Monetta earlier in March, hopeful for a good year. They have stacks of souvenir cups with "2020 season" printed on them. She's not sure how long the Monetta will stay open, and — like other owners — said she would be quick to follow any state-ordered shelter-in-place guidelines. Deciding just to open this weekend, she said, was difficult. And she's worried that other drive-ins won't be able to withstand a few dark months.

But so long as it's safe, Boaz appreciates the irony that in the year 2020, the best — and in many cases only — way to see a movie outside the house is at the drive-in. The pandemic hasn't proven the supremacy of streaming as much as it's shown how indomitable the urge is to spend a night at the movies.

"It is kind of nice that we're getting a little bit of extra attention. Maybe people don't want to stay inside as much as they thought they did," said Boaz. "The old ways are the best ways."

"Star Wars: The Rise of Skywalker"

Devotees of the George Lucas-created "galaxy far, far away" are understandably particular about the treatment of it in each new chapter, and while this latest one — directed and co-written by J.J. Abrams — wraps up a lot, it received mixed reactions from the Jedi-faithful. The race is on by characters both veteran and recently introduced to stop the establishment of a new intergalactic Empire overseen by the Emperor Palpatine (Ian McDiarmid), thought to have been eliminated by king evildoer Darth Vader (whose voice still is furnished by James Earl Jones), and Kylo Ren (Adam Driver). Carrie Fisher appears again as Leia Organa via footage that wasn't used in "Star Wars: The Force Awakens," and Mark Hamill fulfills the title's promise by returning as Luke Skywalker. Daisy Ridley, John Boyega, Oscar Isaac, Lupita Nyong'o, Billy Dee Williams and Anthony Daniels (as C-3PO) also are back, and Richard E. Grant and Keri Russell (who was television's "Felicity" for Abrams) are among notable newcomers. »» (PG-13: V) (Also on Blu-ray and 4K Ultra HD)

"The Current War"

The title of Alfonso Gomez-Rejon's drama is quite clever, since the reference is to "current" as in "electric current" — the source of the 19th-century rivalry between Thomas Edison

and George Westinghouse, played here by Benedict Cumberbatch and Michael Shannon, respectively. As the two innovators competed for cities to adopt the electricity-delivery system each man

had developed, personal and professional hurdles arose in the path of each of them. Nicholas Hoult portrays Nikola Tesla, who lent his own expertise to each of the inventors at one time or another; the fine cast also includes Katherine Waterston, Tom Holland and "Succession's" Matthew Macfadyen. »» (PG-13: AS, V) (Also on Blu-ray and On Demand)

"Mr. Robot: The Complete Fourth Season"

It's entirely possible that without the Emmy-winning success he had with this immensely unique USA Network series, Rami Malek might not have landed the Freddie Mercury role that brought him an Oscar for "Bohemian Rhapsody," nor the central-villain slot in the soon-to-debut James Bond caper "No Time to Die." This concluding stanza of writer-producer-director Sam Esmail's saga finds his character Elliot still a pawn of various forces in a cyberwar, though his life expectancy appears to have been shortened considerably — forcing him to use his own devices, both figurative and literal, to try to prevent that from taking effect. Carly Chaikin, Portia Doubleday, Michael Cristofer, Grace Gummer and BD Wong also continue as cast regulars ... at least when these final stories begin. A "Complete Series" set also is newly available. »» (Not rated: AS, P, V) (Also on Blu-ray)

"Coda"

Though he's on "Star Trek: Picard" turf by reprising a signature character on television these days, Patrick Stewart has quite a different role in this drama, in which he has an intriguing partnership

with Katie Holmes. He plays a veteran concert pianist whose development of stage fright threatens to cripple his career, but the music critic portrayed by Holmes turns out to be a surprising source of encouragement for him to move past his fears. Despite some cliches that the script can't avoid, it provides a solid part for Stewart, and he makes the most of it. Giancarlo Esposito also stars for director Claude Lalo. »» (Not rated: AS, P)

"Munster, Go Home!"

Most of the cast of the mid-1960s sitcom that played horror for laughs transitioned to this 1966 big-screen spinoff, now making its Blu-ray debut. Released just after the television series ended, the tale takes Herman (Fred Gwynne) — the Frankenstein-monster-like patriarch of an offbeat family — to England to claim an inheritance, with the rest of his clan in tow. They're targeted for scares, but their enemies clearly don't realize they're dealing with the Munsters. Yvonne De Carlo, Al Lewis and Butch Patrick continue their roles, and the major recasting is Debbie Watson as relatively "normal" daughter Marilyn. Co-stars include Terry-Thomas, Hermione Gingold, Richard Dawson, Robert Pine (father of Chris) and fright-film staple John Carradine. Special features include the 1981 TV-movie "The Munsters' Revenge," also with Gwynne, De Carlo and Lewis. »» (Not rated)

"Style Queens: Jennifer Lopez"

Continuing a series of profiles that began with Taylor Swift earlier in the month, this portrait of multiple-threat talent Lopez — who recently raised her "buzz"

quotient even higher with her much-discussed performance in the Super Bowl halftime show — focuses primarily on her clothing sense, which has served her well throughout the various facets of her career. That dates back to her early days as a Fly Girl on the series "In Living Color," and she certainly has maintained her place as a style icon through her tenures on "American Idol" and "World of Dance" ... and also in such movies as last year's "Hustlers," which earned her some of the best reviews she's had to date as an actress. »» (Not rated)

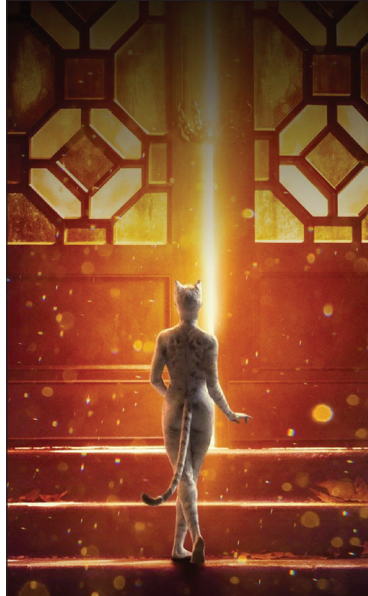
