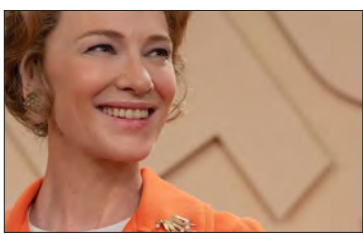

Peacock shows its feathers as streaming service premieres

Its debut date was set before people likely started doing their viewing at home more than ever, and a new streaming service is about to become another option for them.

NBC Universal launches its direct-to-consumer Peacock – named in tribute to the NBC network’s classic logo – in the first of two waves Wednesday, April 15. The customer base of NBC Universal parent Comcast gets it first, then the service will go wide on July 15.

Peacock will mix television and movie classics along with original productions, plus sports, and consumers can choose between versions of the service. At its most basic, Peacock will have “thousands of hours” of programming available – with commercials – for free to Comcast customers and at cost to other consumers, and a paid “Premium” plan will offer even more, commercial-free.

“The Office” (which won’t appear until 2021), “Parks and Recreation” and “Will & Grace” are among Peacock’s crown jewels, with “Friday Night Lights”

and “Parenthood” also among series choices. The Universal movie library will provide a wide range of selections, with “E.T.: The Extra-Terrestrial,” “Jurassic Park” and “Schindler’s List” (all directed by Steven Spielberg, as it happens) as several of the available titles.

Different takes on current TV offerings will be on the Peacock menu, too, with viewers able to watch “The Tonight Show With Jimmy Fallon” and “Late Night With Seth Meyers” several hours earlier. Also, “Best of” editions of CNBC’s “Mad Money” and the syndicated “Access Hollywood” and “The Kelly Clarkson Show” are included.

New shows on Peacock’s docket include reboots of several series that have existed within the NBC Universal universe previously, and here’s a look at several.

“Angelyne”: Emmy Rossum (“Shameless”) stars in the true drama of a Los Angeles icon.

“A.P. Bio”: Starring Glenn Howerton and Patton Oswalt, the school comedy that originated on NBC gets at least one new season on Peacock.

“Battlestar Galactica”: Executive producer Sam Esmail’s (“Mr. Robot”) take on the sci-fi saga pits humans against evil Cylons again.

“Brave New World”: The classic Aldous Huxley novel gets a new treatment starring Alden Ehrenreich (“Solo: A Star Wars Story”), Demi Moore and Jessica Brown Findlay.

“Division One”: Besides “Parks and Recreation,” Amy Poehler supplies something new to Peacock as executive producer of this sitcom about a women’s college soccer team.

“Dr. Death”: Jamie Dornan (“Fifty Shades of Grey”) plays a Dallas doctor whose increasingly lethal methods are probed by two peers (Alec Baldwin, Christian Slater) in this podcast-inspired melodrama.

“Punky Brewster”: Soleil Moon Frye plays an adult Punky in a continuation of the original sitcom.

“Saved by the Bell”: Another much-beloved sitcom brings back initial co-stars Mark-Paul Gosselaar, Elizabeth Berkley and Mario Lopez for this updated version.

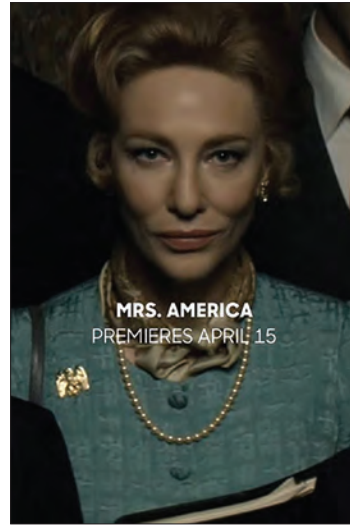


"Movie: Sergio"

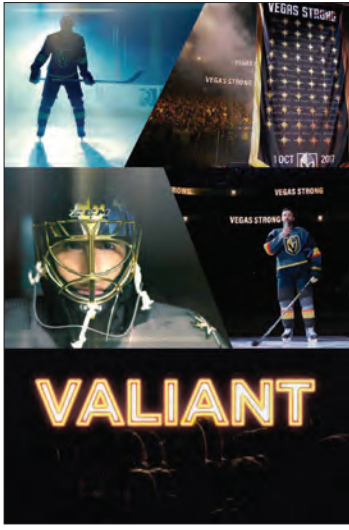

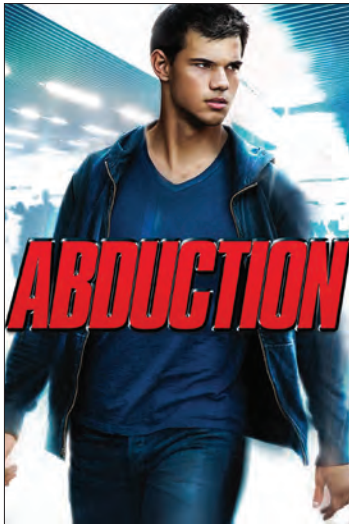
"Movie: Valiant"

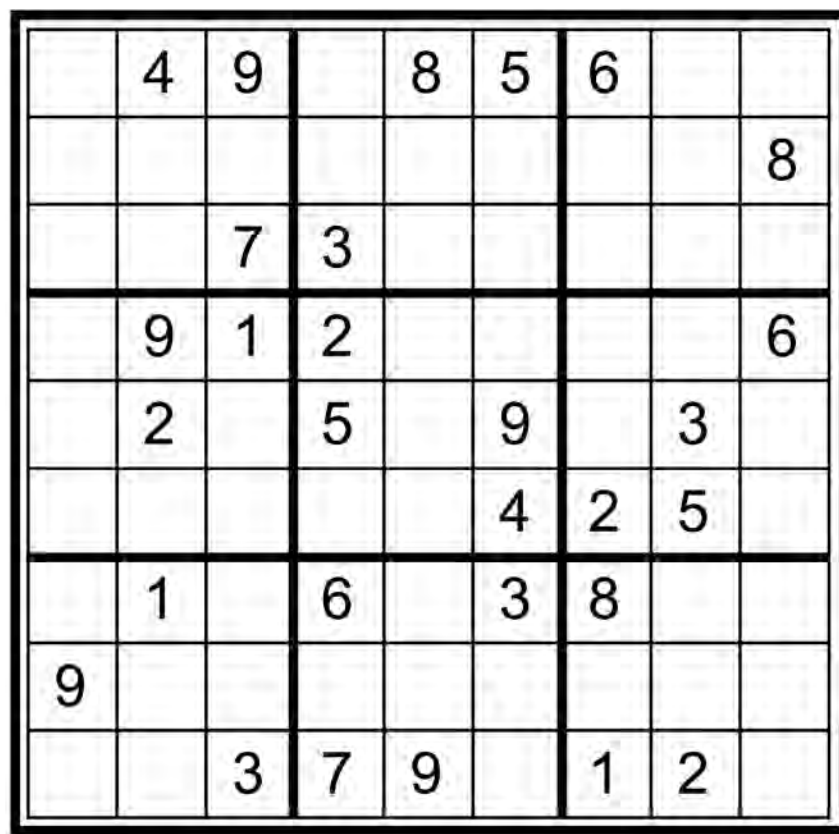

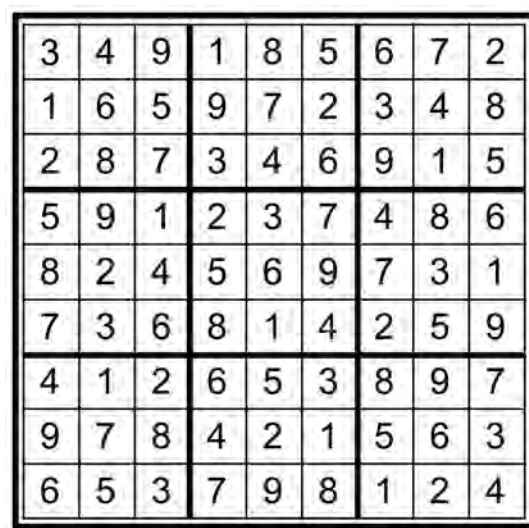

"Amelia" (2009): Bearing quite a resemblance to Amelia Earhart, Swank dramatizes the aviatrix's relationships with the two main men in her life.



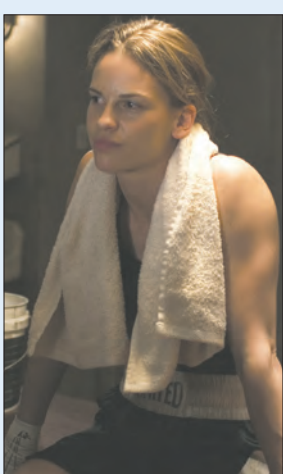

'The Hunt' is on for Hilary Swank

"The Hunt" (available On Demand) is a movie that has had quite a history, prompting strong opinions well before anyone even saw it.

Originally slated for release last fall, it was controversially pulled from being released during a particularly violent period of shooting incidents in America, though it echoes a theme that dates back the better part of a century to the story "The Most Dangerous Game" – and even as recently as "The Purge" – with people hunting people.

In something of an image change, double Oscar winner Hilary Swank plays the ringleader of an elite group that makes a sport out of abducting and then chasing so-called "undesirables." The main target is portrayed by Betty Gilpin, of the streaming series "GLOW," and it truly is a matter of the

survival of the fittest ... not to mention the fastest. However, some of the would-be victims eventually show that they have the stamina and smarts to turn the tables on those who are after them.

Co-written and co-produced by Damon Lindelof of "Lost," "The Leftovers" and "Watchmen" television fame, "The Hunt" has a certain political undercurrent, but it's also a bare-bones action tale with graphic violence to spare. And by the time the principal characters on either side engage in prolonged man-to-man combat – actually, make that woman-to-woman – it's about as raw as such a tale gets. (And it must be added that the physical trainers certainly earned their paychecks for that scene, though Swank is known for staying in prime condition anyway.)

"The Hunt" is admirable in the sense that it doesn't pretend to be anything but what it is. It's a slightly higher-brow exploitation movie, and it's right in the wheelhouse of producer Jason Blum, who has built his reputation on high-concept suspense and horror films that he delivers to studios very economically. For "The Hunt," Swank likely came at a price higher than what he normally pays, but he balanced the budget by populating the rest of the cast with familiar character actors.

Even if you're not generally a fan of such pictures, "The Hunt" is hard to take your eyes away from. But go in knowing that, just as the characters experience over the course of the film, it's probably going to hurt.

FX on Hulu's 'Mrs. America' recalls the roots of the feminist movement

Such names as Gloria Steinem, Betty Friedan and Phyllis Schlafly have very particular places in U.S. social history. Those women played various roles in regard to the Equal Rights Amendment, which the famously conservative Schlafly opposed while making a bid for a House of Representatives seat as the 1970s began. She had a major opponent in author and activist Friedan, one of the principal feminists of the era – and that battleground is dramatized in "Mrs. America," which debuts by streaming the first three of its nine episodes Wednesday, April 15, on FX on Hulu. Also an executive producer of the project, Oscar winner Cate Blanchett stars as Schlafly, with Emmy recipient Tracey Ullman and Rose Byrne respectively playing Friedan and Steinem. With Emmy winner Margo Martindale ("The Americans") and Uzo Aduba ("Orange Is the New Black")

as politicians Bella Abzug and Shirley Chisholm, the cast of "Mrs. America" also includes Sarah Paulson, Elizabeth Banks, Jeanne Tripplehorn, Melanie Lynskey, Ari Graynor and John Slattery ("Mad Men"). "Phyllis herself didn't initially have an issue with the Equal Rights Amendment," Blanchett maintains. "She thought it was a piece of fairly innocuous political business, and her primary focus was defense. That was her passion; that was her area of research and her focus. It wasn't really until – as described in our series – her friend Alice (played by Paulson) turned her on to what were called 'the dangers of the ERA' that meant that women could be drafted. I think it was through the concept of its impact it would have, from her perspective, on the military that she got involved." As the piece's Friedan, Ullman reports that "it was really hard to get this role. I

did really want to be a part of this. I started as a dramatic actress in theater and (since), of course, I have done lots of comedy shows – but I've always portrayed real people, real heart. I like the poignancy and reality and sadness of people, and I've been in America for 30 years. I know people like Betty Friedan. It struck me how incredible it was to write a book like (Friedan's) 'The Feminine Mystique' in 1963." The makers of "Mrs. America" also include veteran studio executive Stacey Sher and "Captain Marvel" filmmaking partners Anna Boden and Ryan Fleck. The latter duo directed the limited series' first two episodes, and Boden reasons, "I don't think any of the actors in the cast did an impersonation. They did a lot of research, and they're all like the most studious actors I've ever worked with. They put us to shame ... in terms of how they tried to embody the characters and their complexities."

"Just Mercy"

Movie history is filled with law dramas that have benefited from fine teamwork by the actors who play attorney and client, and here's another one. Michael B. Jordan portrays a Southern lawyer who makes a specialty of taking up the cases of wrongly convicted inmates on death row. One such prisoner is played by Jamie Foxx, and his claim of innocence in the death of a young woman goes unheard by local authorities, due in large part to the interracial overtones of the crime. Enter the Harvard graduate represented by Jordan, but his good intentions are met with skepticism by just about everyone ... including the convict himself, who's had enough disappointments and is resigned to his apparent fate. However, assisted by a paralegal (Brie Larson), the lawyer finally gets through to his intended client and their work to overturn the conviction begins. Obviously, director and co-writer Destin Daniel Cretton involves a lot of good actors i-also including Tim Blake Nelson as a questionable witness – but the real revelation is Foxx. He largely stifles his usual charisma, a requirement of his role here, and he's extremely effective in a different kind of performance for him. »» (PG-13: AS, P) (Also on Blu-ray and On Demand)

Simpson later.
