

'Perry Mason' returns to lay down the law anew on HBO

Any preconceived notion you might have of "Perry Mason" is about to be tossed out of court. The most enduring image of novelist Erle Stanley Gardner's iconic character surely is the urbane defense attorney played by Raymond Burr in a 1957-66 television classic that remains a staple of nostalgia-driven networks. However, a younger, scrappier Mason fuels a limited HBO series debuting Sunday, June 21. Executive-produced by Robert Downey Jr. and his wife Susan, and set in the Depression era, it casts Matthew Rhys ("The Americans") in the title role while exploring Mason's roots as an unconventional detective as much as a nascent lawyer.

"That is why I jumped at the opportunity," the friendly Rhys confirms of helping to generate a new Mason. "When the initial call came, this strange thing went through my head: 'Perry Mason?' I realize

more and more that I'd had a unique relationship to it without necessarily having a true grasp of what it was. I was aware of the (original) show, but in true recollection, I wasn't sure that I ever watched it ... though my grandparents did.

"You feel like you know this identity of a trial lawyer who got everybody to confess on the stand," adds Rhys, "but as soon as you heard that HBO was remaking 'Perry Mason,' you knew immediately, 'Well, OK. That's going to be a very different take.' And it is. It's the origin story of how he became a trial lawyer, and I thought, 'Oh, how interesting.' And then I read the first script, and that was that."

Such other familiar characters as Della Street (now played by Juliet Rylance) and Paul Drake (Chris Chalk) also are reinvented by the "Perry Mason" reboot. John Lithgow (as Mason's mentor in the law), Tatiana Maslany ("Orphan Black") and Robert

Patrick ("Scorpion") are among the cast members as well. HBO-series veteran Tim Van Patten ("Game of Thrones," "The Sopranos") is the director and an executive producer of the show.

In preparing to play Mason, the Welsh-born Rhys – the real-life partner of his fellow "Americans" star Keri Russell – had a valuable resource in Tom Hanks while they made the recent movie "A Beautiful Day in the Neighborhood," since Hanks had done the similarly styled 2002 film "Road to Perdition."

"When you're engulfed in something on this kind of scale, it's hard not to believe the world you're in," Rhys reasons of the "Perry Mason" costumes and production design that are so evocative of the early 1930s. "You don't see anything but hundreds of supporting actors in the costumes and cars, and whole streets have been made to look the way they were then, so it only strengthens the make-believe."






"Eric Andre: Legalize Everything"


"Crazy Delicious"




"Twilight Zone" (Season 2)





"Kramer vs. Kramer" (1979):

Hoffman's first Oscar came for his great work as a suddenly deserted husband and father.




"Marathon Man" (1976): What's a really bad dental session for the sake of a great thriller?

"All the President's Men" (1976):

Legedary journalists Carl Bernstein and Bob Woodward were portrayed by Hoffman and Robert Redford playing them in the fine film about the reporters' breaking of the Watergate scandal.

"Lenny" (1974): Hoffman perfectly captures the humor and persona of racy comic Lenny Bruce.



"Papillon" (1973): Firmly on character-actor turf with thick eyeglasses and an awkward gait, Hoffman is memorable as the prison pal of a habitual escapee (Steve McQueen).

"Midnight Cowboy" (1969):

Hoffman showed his screen range early as brash Ratso Rizzo, unlikely comrade of studly Joe Buck (Jon Voight).



"The Graduate" (1967): It wasn't his first movie, but the Mike Nichols-directed cultural touchstone about innocent Benjamin Braddock and seductive Mrs. Robinson (Anne Bancroft) certainly was the first film Hoffman attracted attention for. And he still does.

Willy Loman is one of the greatest roles in American drama, so it's only natural that Dustin Hoffman would want to play it.

Legendary for his desire for acting challenges, the two-time Oscar winner seized such an opportunity by taking the lead in Arthur Miller's stage classic "Death of a Salesman" in the mid-1980s ... playing someone who was well beyond Hoffman's own age at the time. Noted director Volker Schlöndorff captured the Broadway performance on film, originally for a 1985 CBS telecast, and that version currently is streaming on Sundance Now.

to his embodying such an older presence. It's all to Hoffman's credit that the novelty fades away after only a few minutes, and his sheer skill soon makes him easily accepted as the aging Loman, for whom fantasy (banded largely on memories of his past) and reality are merging to an ever greater degree.

Wife Linda (played by Kate Reid) and sons Biff and Happy (John Malkovich, who also won an Emmy here, and Stephen Lang) are greatly troubled by Willy's steadily deteriorating condition, which isn't helped by his being a traveling salesman who has to spend many hours and miles on the road. Family conversations



Fans of Hoffman's "Tootsie" – and there are legions of them – could get a brief taste from that movie's opening montages what his Loman might be like, since one of the quick scenes showed him as a senior citizen during a rehearsal (and, in a humorous nod to Hoffman's reputation as a unshakable perfectionist, arguing with the director about how the scene should be done). That was a relative snapshot, but "Death of a Salesman" gives the full picture, and one that earned Hoffman both an Emmy and a Golden Globe Award.

Now that it's more than three decades later, the difference in appearance isn't as striking for the veteran actor. Back then, though, it took some initial adjustment for a viewer to get used

of all sorts result over the course of the story, some of the most memorable ones filled with emotional fury that the expert cast delivers powerfully and brilliantly.

"Death of a Salesman" also was put on film and television both before and after the Hoffman version, including a 1966 rendering that starred Lee J. Cobb – who originated the part on Broadway and is deemed by many to be the definitive Loman – and also was broadcast by CBS. Hoffman's take stands up very well against any others, and it always should remain fascinating to watch how he handled a legendary role he was determined to tackle before his logical time for it.

Season 3 of Showtime's 'The Chi' brings change to Chicago's South Side

Ronnie Davis was always the kind of guy who was his own worst enemy.

Though well-intentioned, the character played by Ntare Mwine in the Showtime drama "The Chi" always seemed to find trouble, whether it was a life of substance abuse and addiction or getting entangled in gun violence endemic to his South Side Chicago neighborhood.

But as Season 3 opens Sunday, June 21, Ronnie appears to be on a path toward healing and redemption, the result of being forgiven by Brandon (former cast member Jason Mitchell) for the shooting death of his younger brother in Season 1 and forgiving his estranged father for deserting him as a child in the Season 2 finale.

It's a change in direction for the character that Mwine finds most welcome.

"I think what happened in Seasons 1 and 2," he says, "was that Ronnie would take one step forward and two steps back. His heart was in the right place but his actions would always take him to that third rail and he'd land in trouble. I think this season was unique in the sense that it wasn't that pattern, and I'm grateful to the writers because that can become predictable.

"But I think this was the first time where Ronnie sort of had a clear North Star," he continues, "and every step that he takes is

moving toward that North Star. ... There's a higher calling."

As Ronnie embarks on his new journey, other characters face challenges. Emmett (Jacob Latimore) finds juggling the demands of business and a growing family a struggle, while Kevin (Alex Hibbert) tries to make a fresh start of it at his new school. Jake's (Michael V. Epps) estranged brother Trig (Luke James) returns to town as a man on a mission and Doua (Curtiss L. Cook) announces a run for mayor of Chicago.

Gone are Brandon (Mitchell, who was fired from the show for misconduct) and girlfriend Jerrika (Tiffany Boone, who left the show), whose absences are explained early on.

As for Mwine, he's enjoying filming the series in Chicago and is heartened by the reception he and his castmates have gotten from locals. As someone who grew up playing hockey in New England, he

initially had reservations about portraying someone from as polar opposite a background as Ronnie, but the feedback he's received indicates they've gotten it right.

"I could not walk a few blocks without getting stopped on the street," Mwine says, "and it really felt like a celebration of the show in a way that hadn't felt like (in) previous seasons because the word was out, people were familiar with it and had seen it or had worked on it.

"And that's what's great about shooting on location," he continues, "is that most of the people who are working on the show are from Chicago and there was a mandate this year and in the second season as well, to employ youth and kids from (a local school), to bring students in from there, so they really were integrated with the community. ... It was great to feel a part of that."

A day of film's fathers

Sunday, June 21, is a day for all dads this year ... including some of the screen's best.

Turner Classic Movies marks Father's Day in the expected way, as daytime host Alicia Malone and nighttime guide Ben Mankiewicz present a number of films revolving around male heads of households. While each has his own circumstances, and in a variety of stories, all of them share a devotion to their families.

The Dad-themed attractions start early that day with "Fiddler on the Roof," director Norman Jewison's 1971 version of the stage-musical hit, with Topol as milkman Tevye – father to five very marriageable daughters. The morning's Eddie Muller-hosted "Noir Alley" title, Samuel Fuller's "Underworld U.S.A." (1961), even has a parental tie: Cliff Robertson plays a man determined to avenge his father's murder by mobsters.

"Our Vines Have Tender Grapes" (1945) offers one of Edward G. Robinson's most touching performances, as a Norwegian farmer and father in the American Midwest. "The Entertainer" (1960) goes darker with a dad, with Laurence Olivier as a theater performer whose daughter (Joan Plowright, who married Olivier after they did the film and the play that inspired it) knows he's

hardly the warm-and-fuzzy type.

The source of a popular television series later (as was Mark Tobey's novel), "The Courtship of Eddie's Father" (1963) casts Glenn Ford as a widower whose young son (the then-"Ronny" Howard, picking up some early tips on filmmaking) is determined to engineer a new romance for him.

A Father's Day on TCM wouldn't be complete without director Michael Curtiz' "Life With Father" (1947), with a wonderful William Powell as the patriarch of the male-dominated Day family, though a co-star named Elizabeth Taylor also is notable as the love interest of one of the sons. Finally, the original "Father of the Bride" (1950) ends the day on another major classic note with Spencer Tracy as the father who frets endlessly over the wedding of his daughter, played by ... Elizabeth Taylor!

The Comedy Central misadventures of Stan, Kyle, Cartman, Kenny and the rest of their animated gang continue their home-video releases with the most recently televised round of Trey Parker and Matt Stone's topical and irreverent comedy. On the subject of subjects, they include immigration and censorship in the case of these 10 episodes, which saw the show hit its 300th story. "Jasper Mall"

Once constant hubs of activity in their communities, shopping malls largely have faced hard times lately – a situation only exacerbated by the coronavirus pandemic keeping people at home and impacting the economy drastically. This documentary from directors Bradford Thomason and Brett Whitford focuses on the

title mall in Alabama, near Birmingham, where business is traced over the course of one year. Its operators desperately try to justify keeping it open, but the combination of standalone superstores and the boom in online shopping delivers a one-two punch that also has been felt at similar sites in numerous other localities. »» (Not rated: P) (Also on Blu-ray)

"Tokyo Olympiad"

The debut of the Criterion Collection edition of this acclaimed 1965 documentary likely was planned to coincide with the latest Summer Olympic Games – now postponed until next year – but at any time, it stands on its own as an accomplished digest of the 1964 competition. Director Kon Ichikawa deployed more than 1000 cameras and used then-revolutionary techniques of presentation to transform the competitors' athletic skills into something almost poetic as seen on the screen over almost three hours. Still, the essence of the Olympics remains on view in its purest form, displaying the very human results of victory and defeat in a raw and real way. »» (Not rated) (Also on Blu-ray)

"Burden"

An unlikely connection develops in writer-director Andrew Heckler's true drama, as ever-excellent Oscar winner Forest Whitaker plays a Southern clergyman who – at a time when community tensions already are near the breaking point – takes in a Ku Klux Klan member (Garrett Hedlund) in the mid-1990s. Though it's expectedly not an easy process, the reverend eventually has a profound impact on his guest, who makes drastic changes in his life as a direct result. Andrea Riseborough, Tom Wilkinson, Tess Harper and actor-musician Usher Raymond also are in the cast. »» (R: AS, P, V)

"Apollo 13: Home Safe"


Though the title of this documentary gives away how the story turned out, thank goodness it was that way ... as anyone who knows the events of the time, or director Ron Howard's acclaimed movie drama about them, already knows. Marking the 50th anniversary of an in-flight crisis that had the world on the edge of its collective seats, the recap recalls the efforts of Mission Control to bring the Apollo 13 spacecraft and its astronauts – including Jim Lovell and Fred Haise, both of whom comment here (Jack Swigert was the third crew member) – back to Earth safely after an onboard malfunction prompted the famous and still-chilling phrase, "Houston, we've got a problem." Legendary flight director Gene Kranz also is among the interviewees, and actual NASA footage is woven into the program. (Not rated)

"Inheritance"

Played by Lily Collins ("Les Misérables"), a lawyer is in for a lot of surprises resulting from a family tragedy in this drama. Her esteemed father's (Patrick Warburton) unexpected death leaves her bequeathed a set of keys, and those turn out to open a bomb shelter that she didn't know existed on the family's estate. What she finds inside it rightfully alarms not only her, but also those closest to her. Connie Nielsen, Simon Pegg, Chace

Crawford and Michael Beach also appear in the suspense tale, whose intended debut at this year's Tribeca Film Festival was canceled due to the coronavirus pandemic. »» (Not rated: AS, P)
