# Experience the original Broadway production of ‘Hamilton’ at home

American television has a proud tradition of bringing award-winning stage productions to the small screen.

Be it a one-off special on a network or long-running PBS series such as “Great Performances” or “Masterpiece Theatre,” anyone who doesn’t live near New York who has wanted to take in a Broadway show has been able to do so without leaving the comfort of their living room.

The latest comes this month with the arrival of “Hamilton.” Premiering Friday, July 3, on Disney+, the Tony-winning play from director Thomas Kail offers a rap-infused look at Alexander Hamilton’s life and formative role in American history. Starring Lin-Manuel Miranda (who also wrote the musical) in the title role, this production is made up largely of filmed performances featuring the original Broadway cast, shot at the Richard Rodgers Theater in June 2016.

It joins a laundry list of stage productions that have introduced TV viewers to what Broadway is all about, including the following.

“Peter Pan” (March 7, 1955; NBC): The original 1954 Broadway play came to television a year later with the same cast, including Mary Martin as the boy who refused to grow up. Martin and co-star Cyril Ritchard (as Captain Hook) took home Tony Awards for their performances. A 2000 production with Cathy Rigby in the starring role also drew rave reviews.

“Cinderella” (Feb. 22, 1965; CBS): An 18-year-old Lesley Ann Warren’s career got a major lift with her starring role in Rodgers and Hammerstein’s iconic musical about a mistreated peasant who finds her prince, though she admitted later to nerves playing opposite decorated screen legends Celeste Holm and Walter Pidgeon. And that’s future “General Hospital” mainstay Stuart Damon as the prince.

“Death of a Salesman” (May 8, 1966; CBS): Arthur Miller’s Tony-winning play about an aging travelling

salesman on the verge of a nervous breakdown starred Lee J. Cobb in the iconic role of Willy Loman, in a cast that also included Stanley Adams, Edward Andrews and Albert Dekker. Sharp-eyed viewers will also notice George Segal and Bernie Kopell (“The Love Boat”) in bit parts.

“Kiss Me, Kate” (March 25, 1968, ABC): Cole Porter’s musical about behind-the-scenes conflict during a stage production of Shakespeare’s “The Taming of the Shrew” featured then-spouses Robert Goulet and Carol Lawrence in the roles of contentious exes Fred and Lilli.

“Oklahoma!” (Nov. 15, 2013, PBS): Fifteen years after it was filmed for the BBC, this 1998 National Theatre of London production came to “Great Performances” with a game Hugh Jackman in the starring role of Cowboy Curly, who tries to win the heart of headstrong Laurey (Josefina Gabrielle) in a singing and dancing extravaganza.

# Beatles' Top 10 Movies

**"Give My Regards to Broad Street"** (1984): Paul McCartney wrote this musical-comedy, in which he plays a version of himself as he tries to recover missing master tapes of his music – with his wife Linda and Ringo Starr also becoming involved.

**"Time Bandits" (1981):** George Harrison became a movie producer of note, one of his most successful ventures being this Terry Gilliam-directed fantasy about a youngster (played by Craig Warnock) who defies time and space to travel to various eras ... often accompanied by dwarves.

**"Live and Let Die" (1973):** McCartney joined the ranks of James Bond theme-song composers as he and spouse Linda devised the title tune (which they performed with Wings, resulting in one of the group's biggest hits) for Roger Moore's debut as Agent 007.

**"Let It Be" (1970):** An Oscar winner for its score, this documentary about the making of The Beatles' same-titled album was the foursome's final tandem screen project – just as the LP was their last studio release.

**"The Magic Christian" (1969):** Ringo Starr commendably held his own opposite the notoriously challenging Peter Sellers in this satire about an orphan and his benefactor, featuring songs composed by McCartney (and performed by Badfinger).

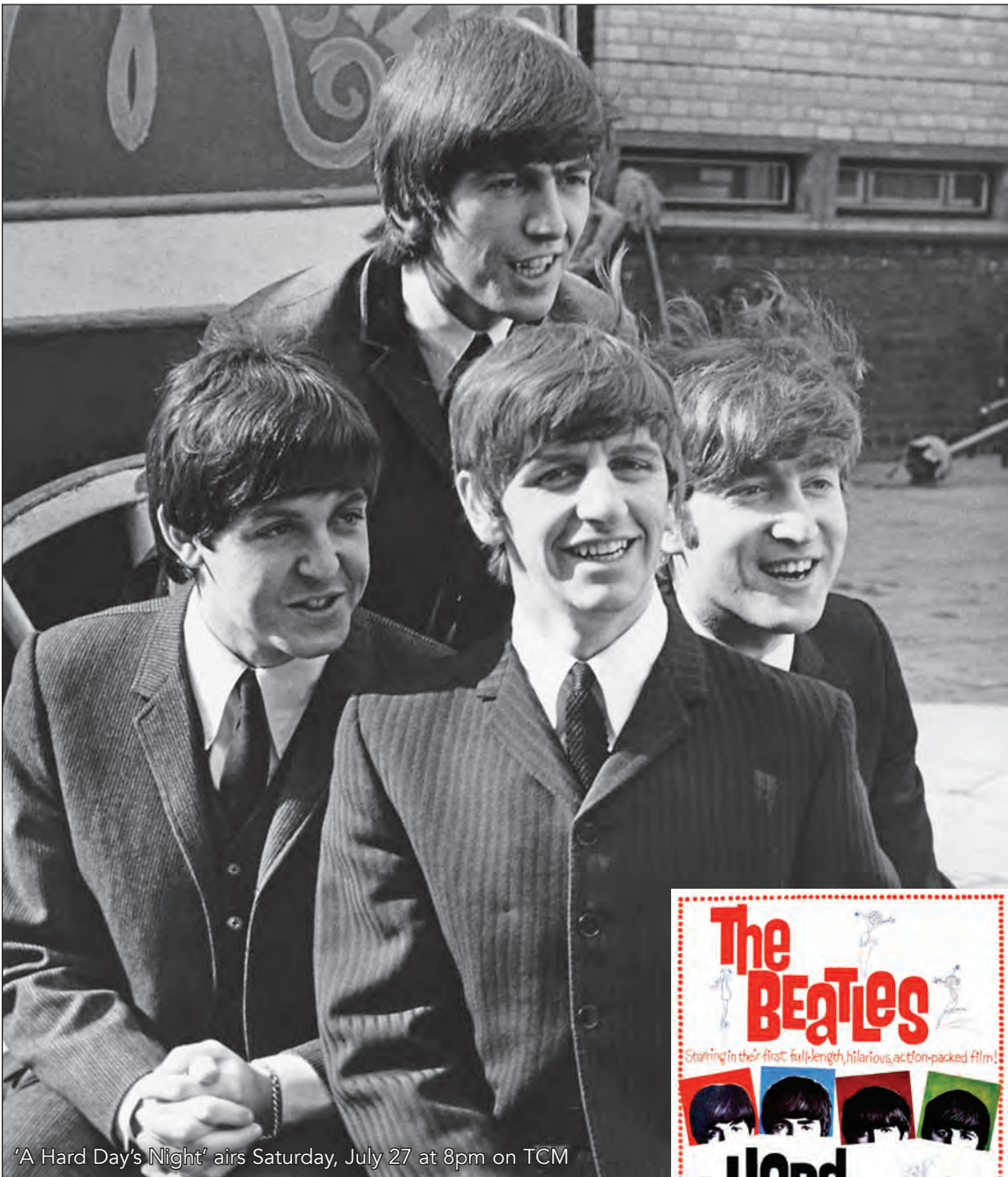
**"Yellow Submarine" (1968):** The actual Beatles didn't appear until the end of the movie, but their animated likenesses were the "stars" of this totally engaging fantasy that found them fighting the Blue Meanies.

**"How I Won the War" (1967):** John Lennon made a bid for solo movie stardom (which ultimately became his one effort toward that) as a World War II soldier in this largely satirical tale.

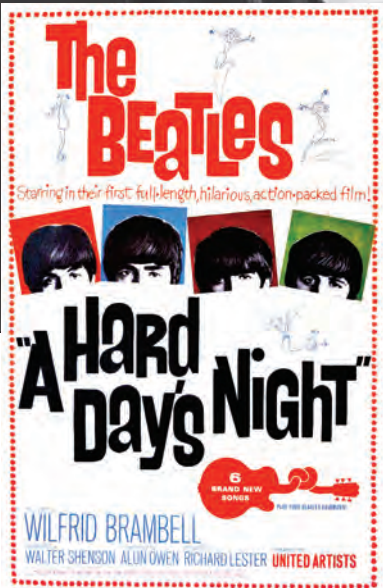
**"Magical Mystery Tour" (1967):** Filmed at a deactivated military airfield and excoriated by reviewers – though it still has value as a Beatles curio – this improvised and highly experimental comedy was made for British television, then released theatrically.

**"Help!" (1965):** A bigger budget and color (!) were added to the Beatles' second movie, sort of a spy spoof that included location filming in the Bahamas ... done while Sean Connery was making the Bond adventure "Thunderball" there.

**"A Hard Day's Night" (1964):** "Beatlemania" already was in high gear when the Liverpool lads' first film was released, and many critics were surprised by the inventiveness of director Richard Lester's "a day in the life" approach to the quartet's hijinks.

## How 'A Hard Day's Night' helped fuel Beatlemania

The Beatles certainly turned the world of music on its ear, but they revolutionized movies, too. The "Fab Four" were getting a hold on the international market for their songs when United Artists agreed to handle their 1964 film "A Hard Day's Night," which Turner Classic Movies shows Thursday, July 2. The picture was conceived as a long commercial for the soundtrack album, but it emerged as much, much more, thanks to the stars' trademark cheekiness and the energetic and inventive directing of Richard Lester. Up to that time, movies that showcased pop music usually were a matter of having the artists simply stand and sing their songs, often backed by a full band that was nowhere to be seen on the screen. "A Hard Day's Night" presented the Beatles romping all over London, often with frenzied fans in close pursuit, and also made a point of frequently showing the lads

playing their guitars (or in Ringo Starr's case, his drums) while performing their tunes. The film also is notable for having Starr, John Lennon, Paul McCartney and George Harrison essentially play themselves ... something that hadn't been done often with such other musically inclined movie stars of the era as Pat Boone and Connie Francis. The fun that the Beatles have with the conceit is evident early in "A Hard Day's Night," during a train trip that finds them introducing Paul's "very clean" grandfather (Wilfrid Brambell) and gleefully antagonizing a stuffy compartment-mate (Richard Vernon). The freeform style of "A Hard Day's Night" is what makes it such a joy. Other rock groups would try to jump on the movie bandwagon soon after, and even the Beatles themselves hit some hurdles trying to duplicate the formula with "Help!" (with Lester as director again), but "A Hard Day's Night's" relatively loose structure set the pace

and remains a giant chunk of its magic. A couple of brief appearances have become legendary over the years since "A Hard Day's Night" initially was released. Pattie Boyd, who plays a student thrilled to encounter the Beatles on the train, would marry George Harrison a couple of years afterward (and Eric Clapton later); and among the studio audience members watching the Beatles stage a TV performance toward the end of the movie is rock-star-to-be Phil Collins. And of course, there are the songs ... literally hit after hit, including not only the title tune (obviously) but "Can't Buy Me Love," "If I Fell," "All My Loving," "I Should Have Known Better," "Tell Me Why," "I'm Happy Just to Dance With You" and "She Loves You." (Yeah, yeah, yeah, indeed.) "A Hard Day's Night" continues to offer countless reasons still to be deemed fresh 55-plus years later, and that fact is likely to hold up for generations to come.

# July 4th TV tradition stays strong amid pandemic

Sometimes, birthdays are celebrated under unusual circumstances ... and so it is for America this year.

The coronavirus pandemic is necessitating changes to various summer traditions, including ways in which the country typically marks the Fourth of July. Those include certain celebrations that not only draw big crowds to the actual sites under normal conditions, but also make for annual television events. The latter will remain the case on Saturday, July 4, but the given shows won't be staged exactly as usual.

PBS' May broadcast of the National Memorial Day Concert gave an idea of what to expect from "A Capitol Fourth" (check local listings), which is marking its 40th-anniversary presentation. Clips from past

years' editions might have been part of the special anyway ... but they'll now form a major portion of the show, as they did with the Memorial Day program from the same producers.

John Stamos returns as host for the fourth time. At press time, it hadn't yet been determined whether he would be in Washington, D.C., or another location (as with Joe Mantegna and Gary Sinise having been in California for the recent Memorial Day special).

However, at least some of the musical acts will perform from Washington, as well as from other cities. Patti LaBelle, country stars Trace Adkins and



Lauren Alaina, the Temptations, Tony Award winner Kelli O'Hara, opera great Renee Fleming and Yolanda Adams are slated to appear, and other artists also will be seen in revisited "A Capitol Fourth" footage.

NBC finds itself in a similar situation as it again stages its "Macy's 4th of July Fireworks Spectacular" in New York. Tim McGraw and Lady A (formerly known as Lady Antebellum) are scheduled to entertain, but any audience directly in front of them is likely to be smaller than usual, due to social-distancing advisories that never were in place before when it came time for the show. Still, spectators will be able to enjoy the colorful sights in the sky from wherever

they are, be that on the streets of the city or at home watching TV.

As for other Independence Day fare, AMC offers – appropriately – the 1996 sci-fi movie hit "Independence Day," and FXM has the 2016 sequel "Independence Day: Resurgence." TNT goes heavily for military-themed films including the 1998 drama "Saving Private Ryan," while Turner Classic Movies salutes pure Americana with such features as 1962's "The Music Man" and two TCM staples of the holiday, the 1972 musical "1776" and James Cagney in the 1942 George M. Cohan biography "Yankee Doodle Dandy."

It may not be the regular sort of July 4th, then, but TV will do its part to keep it as we've known it.

# TCM cheers SFX legend

The name Ray Harryhausen is revered by anyone who knows their fantasy films. Turner Classic Movies marks what would have been his 100th birthday with a night of films boasting his work Monday, June 29.

The evening starts with one of his most celebrated pictures, "The 7th Voyage of Sinbad" (1958), for which he experimented extensively with color film to make sure his stop-motion- animation technique (named "Dynamation") would look realistic enough.


The TCM evening then backs up to 1956 and "Earth vs. the Flying Saucers," in which interstellar vessels invade Washington, D.C. Some of the movie's most memorable, Harryhausen-animated scenes show the spaceships crashing into immediately recognizable landmarks of America's capital.

Then comes "Mysterious Island" (1961), based on Jules Verne's novel about escaped Civil War prisoners who must survive giant mutant birds, bees and the like generated by Captain Nemo (Herbert Lom). "Mighty Joe Young" (1949) runs next, from the makers of "King Kong" and offering some of Harryhausen's earliest work.

Fittingly, the tribute concludes with Harryhausen's last film, "Clash of the Titans" (1981). He and his longtime production partner Charles H. Schneer had the budget to recruit such acting talent as Laurence Olivier and Maggie Smith, but with computer-generated effects coming into their own at that time, the sun was setting on Harryhausen's still-cherished brand.

**"EVIL: SEASON ONE"**

"Disturbing" is a good and very apt word for this CBS series from the mentors of "The Good Wife" and "The Good Fight," writing-producing spouses Robert and Michelle King. Dutch actress Katja Herbers heads the cast as a psychologist who delves into long-unsolved, seemingly supernatural mysteries with religious bents, as she teams with an aspiring priest (Mike Colter). Some of the cases have alarming personal aspects for the investigators. Michael Emerson ("Lost") and Kurt Fuller ("Psych") also are among the stars of the show, which has been renewed for a second season though its first round ended relatively early (accounting for the 13 episodes offered here); Christine Lahti has a recurring role as the psychologist's mother.

**"The Ghost of Peter Sellers"**

One of the most unique talents in movie history, "Dr. Strangelove" and "The Pink Panther" star Sellers also could be famously difficult on film sets, and this documentary recalls one such instance in great detail. Also the director here, Peter Medak ("The Ruling Class") remembers his

dealings with Sellers during the production of "Ghost in the Noonday Sun," a mid-1970s pirate satire that would end up never being released, attributed largely to the alleged problems generated by Sellers as the cameras rolled. Fellow British comedy legend Spike Milligan was brought in to try to fix matters as a screenwriter, but that didn't quite work

out ... as is related here by Medak and some of the other surviving personnel involved in that ill-fated picture, including producer John Heyman and costume designer Ruth Myers.

**"Masterpiece: Beecham House"**

Public-television dramas are famous for stories of daily dynasties, and this 19th-century saga set in India – and being broadcast through mid-July – is the latest. Tom Bateman ("Vanity Fair") heads the ensemble cast as a trading company alumnus and new owner of a mansion where the relationships among several generations undergo their constant ups and downs. Created and directed by "Bend It Like Beckham" filmmaker Gurdhhar Chadha, the story also features Lesley Nicol – familiar to PBS viewers from one of the most successful entries in this genre, "Downton Abbey" – as well as such other veterans of the network as Leo Suter ("Sanditon") and Gregory Fitussi ("Mr. Selfridge").

**"Street Survivors: The True Story of the Lynyrd Skynyrd Plane Crash"**

Among documents of tragedies that claimed the lives of famous people, this one is about as close as it gets ... due to the fact that it's told by Artimus Pyle, then the drummer for the legendary rock band, and a survivor of the 1977 disaster that claimed the lives of individuals including band founder Ronnie Van Zant. Pyle (portrayed in this dramatization by Ian Shultis, with Taylor Clift as Van Zant) helped save others from the wreckage, and the script details the circumstances at the time and Lynyrd Skynyrd's enduring

legacy; some of Pyle's newer music is on the film's soundtrack. Other music stars represented include Aerosmith's Steven Tyler and Joe Perry, respectively portrayed by Neill Byrne and Anthony Rocco Bovo.

**"Christmas in Evergreen: Tidings of Joy"**

Something of a gathering of Hallmark Channel movie all-stars, this pleasant sequel to an earlier holiday tale – not all that out-of-place in the summer, since Hallmark still runs Christmas tales at this time of year – casts Maggie Lawson ("Psych") as a writer who has her doubts about the supposed innocence and purity of a town where the yuletide spirit always is maintained. Of course, she visits to see for herself ... and of course, her skepticism ultimately is turned around. Jill Wagner, Ashley Williams, Holly Robinson Peete and Barbara Niven return from earlier films in the franchise, and Paul Greene also stars. The naturally seasonal soundtrack features Carrie Underwood among others.

**"Ski Bum: The Warren Miller Story"**

For many years, filmmaker Miller's documentaries about skiers and their exploits were major events for his fans during limited runs in theaters, and he's the subject of a documentary himself in the case of this profile of his life and work. Miller passed several months after giving an extensive interview for the film, which traces the challenges he faced in building his own business to help promote the ski industry. Over the better part of five decades, he largely lived out of a trailer while spending hours pursuing the breathtaking outdoor

footage that made him a brand name ... and interestingly, he often traveled with his movies to showplaces near ski resorts, so that he could work on the next one while exhibiting the current one.
