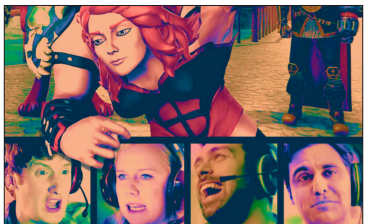
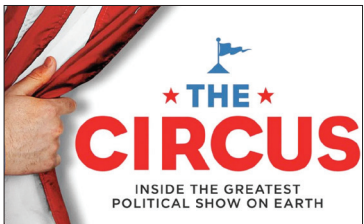

A damaged young soul finds her fixer in Amazon's 'Chemical Hearts'

Grace Town is a broken young woman – emotionally and physically.

As played by Lili Reinhart (“Riverdale,” “Hustlers”) in the Amazon romance/drama movie “Chemical Hearts,” premiering Friday, Aug. 21, she’s a New Jersey high-school senior left with a badly injured knee and psyche by a car accident that claimed the life of her boyfriend. Now sullen and withdrawn, the once-popular athlete is content to push away the outside world and wallow in despair. And her home life is, to say the least, rather unusual.

Into her life comes Henry Page (Austin Abrams, “Paper Towns,” “Brad’s Status”), with whom she is partnered as editors of their school paper. Henry is a bright, sensitive kid from a good home who likes to fix things, and in Grace he sees, perhaps subconsciously, his next project. He’s immediately smitten with her and wants to help her through her grief, a little too quickly

in her opinion. As their friendship turns to love, she realizes she may not be ready for what he has to offer.

The story is based on the novel “Our Chemical Hearts” by Krystal Sullivan and the title refers to the chemical reactions in the brain that result from love. Reinhart says she was attracted to the story because of its depiction of young love that didn’t feel sugar-coated.

“I think one of the messages of the story to me ... was you cannot force someone’s hand into loving you if they’re not ready,” the actress says. “And I think it’s easy to be selfish when it comes to love. And if you have feelings for someone and maybe it’s unrequited and you desperately want them to be with you, you shouldn’t have to convince someone to love you. And I think Grace just wasn’t ready. She wanted to be but she wasn’t and it really pained Henry to have to give that up because she wasn’t ready.”

Reinhart, also an executive producer here, filmed the movie over three weeks last year in New Jersey

before going off to shoot Season 4 of “Riverdale.” She enjoyed her time working with Abrams, a longtime friend, and playing Grace, even if it was brief.

“I’m playing Betty Cooper on ‘Riverdale’ and I get to play Betty for nine months out of the year,” she explains. “So it’s kind of like you want to settle into these characters and suddenly you only have three weeks to play someone and then it’s over.

“I spent months ahead of time figuring out who I wanted Grace to be,” she continues, “and working on the script and working on the dialog between her and Henry. Like you just put so much work into one character and then suddenly it’s over and you have to let it go and you’re not going to play that character again. But the beautiful part is that – and I think I’ll feel better once the movie’s out in the world – Grace’s character is still out there. It’s like people will be able to find themselves within her and the character lives on basically even though I’m done playing it.”

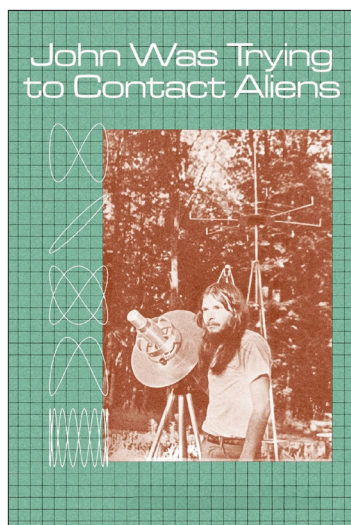

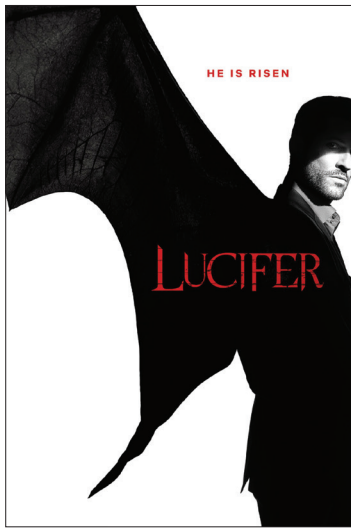
"Hoops"

"Lucifer"

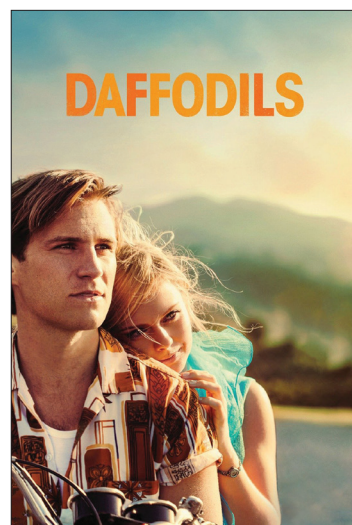

Two ‘Godfathers’ endure as classics

One story gave cinema two of its greatest films ever.

A testament to the matching popularity and quality of “The Godfather” and “The Godfather, Part II” is that one usually isn’t televised without the other, and AMC will show both again Sunday, Aug. 16. “The Godfather, Part III” is widely considered the weak link of the series, and if it’s televised along with the other two, it’s often relegated to the late-late-night hours ... like a relative who gets seated away from most others at a family gathering.

However, to coin a phrase, two out of three isn’t bad – and in the case of the first two “Godfathers,” both Oscar winners for best picture, it’s downright great. Francis Ford Coppola still was something of a Hollywood newcomer when he directed the first film taken from Mario Puzo’s novel about an organized-crime family, a 1972 epic in which Marlon Brando looms large as patriarch Vito Corleone even when he isn’t physically on the screen.

“The Godfather” made an immediate star of Al Pacino, who had a rich arch for his character Michael Corleone, an idealistic military veteran who isn’t sold on the family business until its effects hit too close to home and prompt him to step up. James Caan also made a big impression as Sonny, the Corleones’ resident hothead whose knee-jerk reactions prove to be his undoing. And as weak-willed sibling Fredo, John Cazale is one

of the saga’s most tragic figures, trying to do well by his loved ones even if it means unwisely acting against them in the immediate moment.

Robert Duvall, Diane Keaton, Talia Shire (Coppola’s sister), Richard Conte, John Marley, Sterling Hayden and Alex Rocco also are members of the superb cast of the first “Godfather.” Pacino, Duvall, Keaton, Shire and Cazale would carry over to “The Godfather, Part II,” for which Coppola followed the brilliant premise of drawing a parallel between the young Vito in extensive flashbacks (played by Robert De Niro, earning his first Academy Award) and Michael, as his power grew and temperament changed.

“Sequel” doesn’t seem the right word to use in the case of Coppola’s 1974 follow-up, since it very legitimately is a “Part II” to the original film, following through as a solid continuation more than a tacked-on afterthought. It expands the Corleones’ footprint to Las Vegas and offers excellent supporting roles to Michael V. Gazzo, G.D. Spradlin, Troy Donahue and legendary acting teacher Lee Strasberg. Another major contributor to both movies is composer Nino Rota, whose main theme is one of the most instantly identifiable pieces of music in screen history.

As their 50th anniversaries approach, “The Godfather” and “The Godfather, Part II” are destined to remain two of the most essential motion pictures ever made. Quite simply, they’re offers you can’t refuse.

- “The Irishman” (2019):** Pacino returned to form in his first teaming with director Martin Scorsese, playing labor-union icon Jimmy Hoffa and succeeding by portraying the man’s essence rather than attempting an imitation.
- “Donnie Brasco” (1997):** In what some deem his best performance, Pacino plays a low-level gangster who unwittingly mentors an undercover FBI operative (Johnny Depp).
- “Heat” (1995):** They weren’t seen together in “The Godfather, Part II,” so this cat-and-mouse game between Pacino and Robert De Niro – as a cop and a crook – made their tandem scene worth the wait.

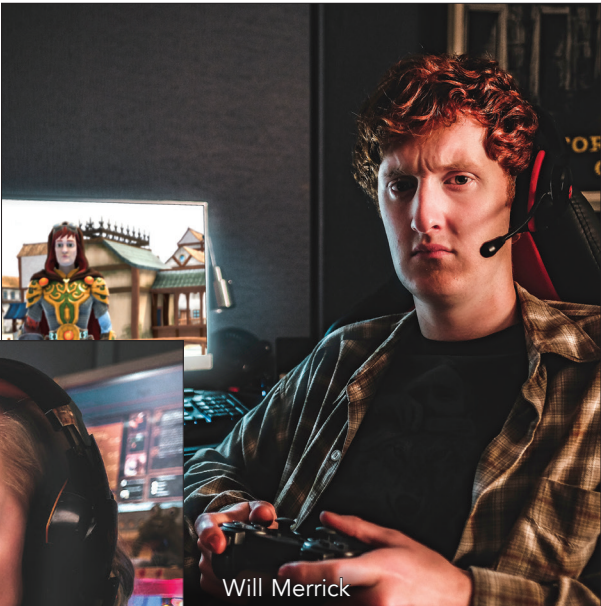

Showtime’s political documentary series “The Circus” resumes

Many people are having to learn new ways of doing things, including the makers of “The Circus: Inside the Craziest Political Campaign on Earth.” The Showtime series recapping the previous week in politics resumes new Season 5 episodes Sunday, Aug. 16, but in a much different world than it left off in. The coronavirus pandemic was in its early days in the U.S. then, and “Circus” hosts John Heilemann, Mark McKinnon and Alex Wagner still had reasonably open access to those on the campaign trail — often hopping into the back seat of a car or aboard a bus with them. But now, as the parties’ conventions start? Maybe not so much. “Our timing really hasn’t changed,” explains the friendly McKinnon, who has consulted on campaigns for President George W. Bush and the late Sen. John McCain among others. “Our season in the spring was scheduled to run through when we knew what was happening with the primaries, and we only cut that short by one week because of COVID-19. Then

our plan was to come back for the conventions, and those changed from July to August, so we’re going to go cover those. “Now, the question is, ‘What does that mean?’” McKinnon notes. “We’re not exactly sure, because the Democrats and Republicans haven’t been sure. What are we going to cover, and how are we going to cover it? The good thing about our show and its format is that we’re really nimble. We often change our schedule day to day. The bottom line is that this will be ‘Circus’-style, fast and furious.” The racial situation and the economy in the United States also are certain to be “Circus” topics in the coming weeks, and McKinnon reports Season 5 will continue until the week after the presidential election. He also promises the hosts’ group-meal scene that opens each episode will remain. “It requires all of us being indoors in one place,” McKinnon acknowledges. “On a number of occasions, we’ve all been in different places and connecting (via technology) for our roundtable, so that’s what you’re likely to see.”

“The Outpost”
CNN anchor Jake Tapper’s best seller about the Battle of Kamdesh makes an intense and excellent movie in the hands of film critic-turned-filmmaker (and West Point graduate and military veteran) Rod Lurie. It tells the true story of a U.S. unit stationed in the midst of three mountains in Afghanistan, where the soldiers become targets of the Taliban and defend themselves in a monumental battle that largely was – as indicated by the subtitle of Tapper’s book – “An Untold Story of American Valor.” Scott Eastwood (Clint’s son), Orlando Bloom and Caleb Landry Jones (whose real-life counterpart, Ty Carter, is among the veterans featured in the film) lead the cast, which also includes other relatives of famous individuals: Milo Gibson (son of Mel), James Jagger (son of Mick), Will Attenborough (grandson of actor-director Richard) and Scott Alda Coffey (grandson of Alan Alda). »» (R: AS, P, GV) (Also on Blu-ray and On Demand)

“Batwoman: The Complete First Season”
With the exit of star Ruby Rose, The CW will be installing a new Batwoman in the series’ second season, so here’s a chance to see the DC Comics-based show in its original form. Often while wearing a terrific costume, Rose does an extremely and commendably physical job of playing Kate Kane, who assumes the absent Batman’s mission of

protecting Gotham from criminal elements – a pursuit that often puts her in conflict with her father (Dougray Scott), a military veteran turned private-security-firm chief. Rachel Skarsten gets to vamp it up wonderfully as Kate’s half-sister, who turns out to be Batwoman’s chief enemy. “Military Wives”
The Oscar-winning drama “Coming Home” dealt in part with how spouses handled being separated from their military mates during times of war, and so does this comedy-drama based on a true story that also inspired a documentary series. In a sad irony, this profile of music icon Rogers was awaiting its A&E Network telecast at the time he passed away last March. While his first successes on the charts were largely pop tunes with the group he fronted, the First Edition, Rogers secured enduring success as a solo act by gravitating toward country music – which he supported with frequent concert tours and acting in projects such as the TV movies inspired by his single “The Gambler.” Dolly Parton (with whom he collaborated famously on “Islands in the Stream”), Lionel Richie, Reba McEntire, Little Big Town and Chris Stapleton are among those commenting on the life and

New York’s law-and-order Reagan family has a new member, thanks to son Jamie (Will Estes) marrying former police partner Eddie (Vanessa Ray), but it also gets another one – someone the relatives didn’t even know existed – in the course of this latest season of the perennially well-written and well-acted CBS drama series. In other developments, Frank (Tom Selleck) has to deal with alleged police brutality, and Erin (Bridget Moynahan) weighs a professional opportunity at the behest of the new mayor (guest star Dylan Walsh), and Danny and Baez (Donnie Wahlberg, Marisa Ramirez) are teamed uncomfortably with a Texas Ranger (guest star Lyle Lovett) on a case. Treat Williams reprises his guest role as Frank’s ex-partner. Len Cariou, Sami Gayle, Gregory Jbara, Robert Clohessy and Abigail Hawk also star. »» (Not rated: AS, P, V)

“Elvis: The Classic Broadcasts”
Though much of the iconic Elvis Presley’s image was built on popular movies he made – in which he typically also sang several songs – he also proved what a dynamo he was as a music performer in television appearances that spanned his stardom. This release compiles many of those, from his rarely seen guest shots of 1950s variety programs to celebrated concert

specials he did in the ‘60s and ‘70s. Admittedly, the content reflects the physical changes Presley went through over the years, but the evidence here leaves no room for dispute that he gave his all to melodies in genres ranging from gospel to pop. »» (Not rated)
